With only 50 riders' positions available we strongly encourage you to get in early, and return your nomination forms, including full payment, as soon as possible to ensure your place on the tour is secure.

The event provides mountain biking enthusiasts with the chance to be involved in a friendly event, while raising vital funds for Westpac Life Saver Rescue Helicopter.

Please read carefully through the following information as there have been a number of changes from previous years.

The Route:

The tour will commence at Lismore from the Westpac Life Saver Rescue Helicopter base on October 8 2011. Riders and support crew will stay overnight for seven nights at:

- Motor vehicles can be left next to the rescue helicopter base at Lismore (at your risk) for the week, however cars will be in the open and the area is unsecured.
- Accommodation will consist of hotels, motels, cabins, backpackers and halls.
- **All riders/crew will require camp mattresses or mats, sleeping bags and pillows. All riders/crew must bring their own tent.**

Payment & Fundraising:

Three years ago, Derek Morrison, the editor of Australian Mountain Bike magazine, told us that the 'Hell on Wheels' tour is the best value for money tour in Australia. And he was right!

Apart from a fully organised mountain bike adventure with support crew and vehicles, first aid personnel, lots of fun and great company, riders receive:

- a SCODY ride jersey
- a quality polo shirt
- a t-shirt
- 7 nights' accommodation
- 7 breakfasts
- A minimum of 4 lunches

Note: Riders to pay as you go for dinner meals (pre-organised with venue).

Note: The tour support crew, receive the same benefits, without the rider jersey.

This year, there is a rider contribution fee (a tax free component). However, riders still have the option to raise the \$200 (or more) via sponsorship, and the donor then receives the tax benefit.

If sponsorship sales do not cover the \$200, the rider must pay the balance.

Prices for this year's Hell on Wheels Tour are:

Rider - hotels/cabins/caravan/camping (shared accom) - **\$650.00**

Rider contribution - **\$200**

Volunteer - hotels/cabins/caravan (shared) or camping - **\$240**

Long Sleeve Rugby Top - **\$50**

Rider's Knicks - **\$110**

All participants are required to complete the Rider Registration form, when returning full payment to Westpac Life Saver Rescue Helicopter.

As there are only 50 rider positions, priority will be determined by order of receipt of entry form and full payment. Once clothing has been ordered the payment for the tour is non-refundable.

Because of the enquiries we have already received we expect the tour will fill quickly this year, so we suggest you do not delay if you want to be on the tour. We have enclosed the rider registration form and accommodation requirements information about sponsorship you if wish to show a business.
